



Open Learning Platform Tips

AI4ALL's [Open Learning](#) is a free, adaptable, classroom-based artificial intelligence (AI) education program. Here is a short guide on how to access Open Learning through the platform website: olp.ai-4-all.org

New User Platform Registration:

- Required materials: access to a computer (not mobile device) with internet connection.
- Teachers and students over 13 years old can register on the platform olp.ai-4-all.org.
- Select **"Register"** to create a username and password.
- Enter the code "EXPLORE" in the final cell.

Platform Tips:

- View all available curriculum under **"View All My Courses and Learning Plans"**. New curriculum is released periodically throughout the year.
- Supplementary lessons are available under **"My Course Catalogs"**.
- Each curriculum comes with **"Unit Plans and Facilitation Guides"**. These contain a variety of teacher resources for implementing the program and facilitating inclusive group discussions.
- ExploreAI comes with Unit Plans and Facilitation Guides tailored for approximately 10, 20, and 30 hours of curriculum.
 - **10 hours** contains Units 1 & 5.
 - **20 hours** contains Units 1, 2, & 5.
 - **30 hours** contains all Units, 1-5.
- At the bottom of each Unit view there are **"Forums"** where you can join online discussions of questions posed in the curriculum or create new discussions.
- Once you finish the program, you can tell us more about your experience in the **"AI4ALL Open Learning Program Feedback Survey"** on the platform. This will help us as we continue to develop the program and build new curriculum modules!
